

"These clauses are purely illustrative. Different policy conditions may be agreed. The specimen clauses are available to any interested person upon request. In particular:
(a) in relation to any clause which excludes losses from the cover, insurers may agree a separate insurance policy covering such losses or may extend the clause to cover such events;
(b) in relation to clauses making cover of certain risks subject to specific conditions each insurer may alter the said conditions".

JCC GLOBAL CARGO WATCH LIST UPDATE

Although the JCC did not meet at the beginning of August, it did review recommendations received from Exclusive Analysis relating to the Global Cargo Watch List (GCWL). As a result of this review, the following changes were made:

Location Descriptions - No changes.

Addition/Removals - No changes.

Risk Level Changes - No changes.

Risk Score Changes

Central African Republic Severe 3.7 from Severe 3.6: The recent raid on an Areva site and other attacks by the LRA increase risk to land cargo.

Ecuador High 2.7 from High 3.1: Blocking of Pan-American Highway and other key highways by protest groups has reduced and disruption is likely only to last for days, rather than weeks.

Iraq Severe 4.2 from Severe 4.4: Despite recent coordinated IED attacks on government personnel and installations, and on Shia civilians, threat to aviation cargo has reduced and no indication of increased intent to target land cargo.

South Sudan Severe 3.9 from Severe 4.2: South Sudan's current engagement in negotiations with Sudan reduces war risks and consequent disruption to land cargo.

Syria Severe 5.6 from Severe 5.5: Fighting at border crossings, resulting in their closure, and in Damascus and Aleppo increases risks to land cargo and of collateral damage to cargo at airports.
