



"These clauses are purely illustrative. Different policy conditions may be agreed. The specimen clauses are available to any interested person upon request. In particular:
(a) in relation to any clause which excludes losses from the cover, insurers may agree a separate insurance policy covering such losses or may extend the clause to cover such events;
(b) in relation to clauses making cover of certain risks subject to specific conditions each insurer may alter the said conditions".

BERING SEA TRANSIT CLAUSE

Notwithstanding anything contained in this insurance to the contrary, it is hereby agreed that the insured vessel may navigate the Bering Sea on through voyages and provided that

- (a) the vessel does not enter, navigate or remain north of 54° 30' N. Lat.; and
- (b) the vessel enters and exits west of Buldir Island or through the Amchitka, Amukta or Unimak Passes; and
- (c) the vessel is equipped and properly fitted with two independent marine radar sets, two independent global positioning system receivers, one of which is capable of being set on a different, independent satellite positioning system to the other (such as US GPS, Russian GLOSNASS, European Galileo, Chinese Compass), a radio transceiver and GMDSS, a weather facsimile recorder (or alternative equipment for the receipt of weather and routing information) and a gyrocompass, in each case to be fully operational and manned by qualified personnel; and
- (d) the vessel is in possession of appropriate navigational charts corrected up to date, sailing directions and pilot books.
