

"These clauses are purely illustrative. Different policy conditions may be agreed. The specimen clauses are available to any interested person upon request. In particular:
(a) in relation to any clause which excludes losses from the cover, insurers may agree a separate insurance policy covering such losses or may extend the clause to cover such events;
(b) in relation to clauses making cover of certain risks subject to specific conditions each insurer may alter the said conditions".

RECOMMISSIONING WARRANTY

Warranted the Vessel shall not sail from lay-up berth under own power or navigate following a lay-up period of more than 180 consecutive days unless the Assured has arranged for Lloyd's Register or the London Salvage Association to examine the Vessel and has carried out any repairs or requirements recommended by Lloyd's Register* of the London Salvage Association.

* The Joint Hull Committee also agreed that inspections of vessels, prior to returning to service after being laid-up for 180 days or longer, by:

Germanischer Lloyd

Bureau Veritas

American Bureau of Shipping

are acceptable within the terms of the "Recommissioning Warranty".

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
