SHALLOW WATER FLOW EXCLUSION (JR 04/001)

There shall be no indemnity or liability under this policy for:

Any loss, damage or expense caused by or resulting from "Shallow Water Flow". Shallow Water Flow is defined as a flow of water with or without formation material from or into a wellbore, or outside of the well casings, which flow originates in formations at depths of less than 3,500 feet below the water bottom, which occurs in wells with a water depth of 600 feet or greater.
