

1/2/80 "These clauses are purely illustrative. Different policy conditions may be agreed. The specimen clauses are available to any interested person upon request. In particular:  
(a) in relation to any clause which excludes losses from the cover, insurers may agree a separate insurance policy covering such losses or may extend the clause to cover such events;  
(b) in relation to clauses making cover of certain risks subject to specific conditions each insurer may alter the said conditions".



## INSTITUTE YACHT CLAUSES TRANSIT CLAUSE

In consideration of the payment of an additional premium of ....  
..... it is agreed to extend  
this insurance to cover the Vessel in transit by road, rail, car-ferry or air,  
including loading and unloading from the conveyance, within .....  
.....  
..... but no claim shall be allowed in respect of

- (a) Scratching, bruising and/or denting arising during transit covered by this Clause and the cost of consequent repainting or revarnishing,
- (b) Liability to third parties arising from any accident while the Vessel is being towed by or is attached to a motor vehicle or has broken away or become accidentally detached from a motor vehicle.
