- (a) in relation to any clause which excludes losses from the cover, insurers may agree a separate insurance policy covering such losses or may extend the clause to cover such events;
 - (b) in relation to clauses making cover of certain risks subject to specific conditions each insurer may alter the said conditions”.



RUBBER-SHIPMENTS TO UNITED KINGDOM ONLY

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, if the goods do not go into a warehouse for sampling at port of destination, except, if required, to the extent of a 10% sampling in transit but are forwarded to the interior by inland conveyances, the insurance shall continue until delivery there to warehouse or factory.

It is a condition of this insurance that the Assured shall act with reasonable despatch in all circumstances within their control.
